

Newsletter – June 2025



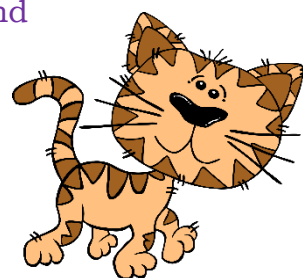
Dear Parents/Carers,

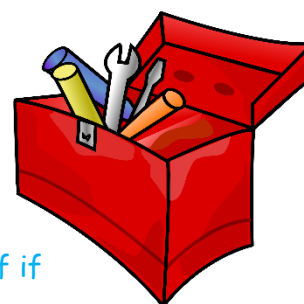

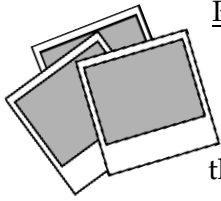

How to keep your kids safe on the Internet (0-5 years) – As a setting we feel that it is important that your children are kept safe, therefore we recommend that you:

- Are aware of what your child is looking at, as even child-friendly sites can be hacked.
- Have all online activity take place in a common area of the house, where others are present.
- Keep children under the age of 11 from being on any social media platforms.
- Regulate the amount of time that your child is online.
- Apply parental controls where possible, but don't trust that they will catch all inappropriate content.
- Know what sites your children are accessing and get a feel for the content.

Tapestry – Please do continue to post on your child's Tapestry account as this continues to help with their development and achievements. Photos from home are useful to us as it may show us what your child can do, which they may not possibly do at nursery with us.
